It brings smoothness and delicacy; its spicy and peppery aromas enrich the aromatic complexity of the wine. It is a lively and elegant wine with silky tannins. Its personality makes the Burgale Rouge a wine to be drunk either young or aged.

Fer Servadou is a great wine with very characteristic aromas of <b>blackcurrant and wild berry</b> , combining <b>strength and elegance</b> with a very good ability to age.

Its deep and lingering tannins distinguish it from the other wines. It offers a large aromatic range that will develop with time (red berries, liquorice, truffle, violet, chocolate, etc.).
